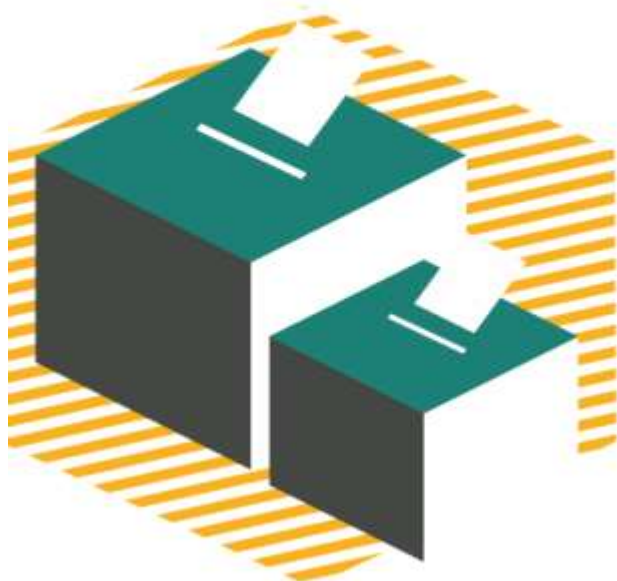

# CEO UPDATE



**WEDNESDAY, 29 JANUARY 2025**

A belated "Happy New Year" to everyone!

Whilst some families may still be away on holidays, in general many of the community are returning, especially as school will shortly be recommencing. I hope everyone had a good break, however long that was, and to those that haven't been away, I hope your time was well spent. I hope that 2025 is a fantastic year for everyone. In keeping with previous practice, I have some information on a few matters that I would like to update you on:

**Australia Day** - Thank you to everyone that attended the Australia Day breakfast at the District Club and afternoon at the Aquatics facility. Thank you to Michelle and her team (Mi Familia Flavours), who provided the breakfast. We had more than 180 people attend in the afternoon, enjoying, a BBQ, DJ and the fabulous pool and its facilities. I must commend the Shire team, Nerea, Brett, Shayna, Rebecca, Andrew, Mia, Lia and Marolyn for all of their hard work on Sunday to ensure everyone had a great time at a fabulous location; great job everyone!

**Unleaded Fuel** - You would have noticed the Shire's Works Crew has been undertaking the required site works over the last few weeks; additionally, it was pleasing to see the two tanks delivered and in situ now. I have spoken to Great Southern Fuels, and we are now awaiting the delivery of the bowsers. This is expected shortly and then the final trench work will be undertaken to enable the electricians to complete their work to enable connection and subsequent completion not too long afterwards. Whilst there is no confirmed date for all of this to be completed, we are not far away from normal service being resumed. I will continue to keep everyone informed as this work progresses.

**Bushfire 24 January 2025** - Friday bore witness to a bushfire starting on the Bruce Rock / Merredin Road at the junction of Fuchsbichler Road at about 2pm. As always, our valued volunteer firefighters turned out to combat this blaze which, for a time, was the cause of significant concern, however the professionalism of our firefighters from across the Shire as well as volunteer fire fighting units from the Shire's of Merredin, Corrigin and Narembeen all assisted and ensured that the fire was contained approximately six (6) hours later, with crews maintaining a vigil at the containment areas throughout the weekend.

I am sure that I speak on the communities behalf, in thanking the Department of Fire and Emergency Services (DFES), and all the firefighters from across our local districts and other Shires for their outstanding efforts and selfless commitment to protecting our community.





# CEO UPDATE



**WEDNESDAY, 29 JANUARY 2025**

I am aware that some residents were very concerned about this fire, however I wish to reassure all members of our community that like all other Local Governments, the Shire of Bruce Rock has a very comprehensive Emergency Management Plan and follows a strict and controlled process during any bushfire emergency, and that staff are well trained and adept to responding to the necessary requirements to manage a situation, such as the bush fire on Friday, which was close to the Bruce Rock townsite (7kms). On Friday, the Shire staff were well briefed and ready to deal with any emerging situation and we were even prepared to receive evacuees at the Town Hall. When bushfires escalate the Shire assumes a clearly directed liaison role and supports the Hazard Management Agency (HMA) managing the incident. Any communication to residents throughout the Shire has to be done in a strictly coordinated manner and the Shire should not update its social media and other means unless directed to do so by the HMA, Dept of Communities or DFES. The Emergency WA, DFES App and website, ABC and other radio stations etc. are a sure and sound way to remain updated at this time and I assure everyone that if there had been a requirement to put out additional communication and instruction, we would have done so.

**Community Sundowner** – The Shire looks forward to hosting the community at the Annual Community Sundowner on Friday the 21 February 2025, at the Bruce Rock District Club. We look forward to celebrating a Citizenship Ceremony as well as our winners of our Sports and Volunteer awards. More information will be sent out shortly so save the date and look forward to a great evening at the Club.

**Farewell** - This week we say farewell to two (2) staff members who have served this community so well. Firstly, Julian Goldacre, (Manager Regulatory Services), has worked with the Shire for a number of years and demonstrated a passion and commitment to this community. I wish to assure the community that Regulatory Services will continue to be available and will communicate who is replacing Julian next week. I am sure all of you would like to join me and all the Shire staff in wishing Julian all the very best in his future endeavours; the best of luck Julian and thank you for all you have done. Last but not least we say farewell to Shayna Campbell, our Community Development Officer. Shayna has been a wonderful asset to the Shire in the years that she has worked here, and the partnerships with community groups to ensure productive relationships and excellent events are a credit to her application to the role and diligence. Whilst she is not leaving the community, just the Shire team, we wish her all the very best and thank you Shayna for all your hard work, passion, and personality, it's been great working with you.

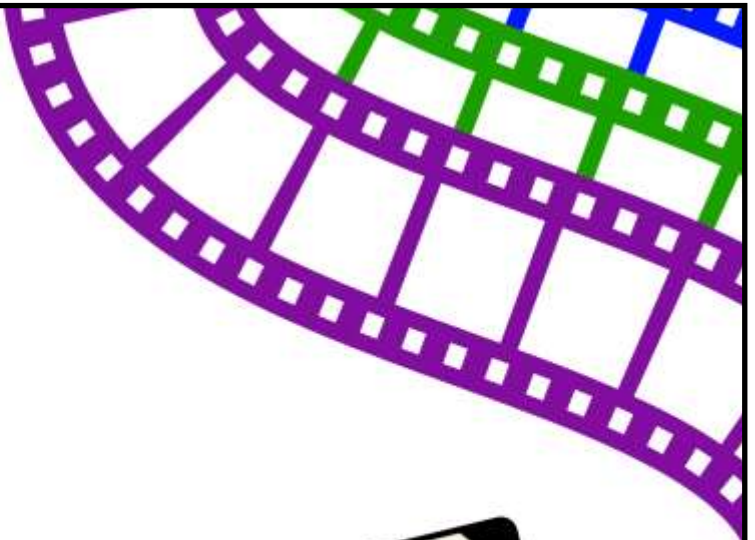

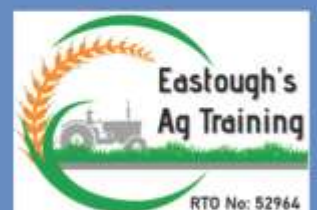

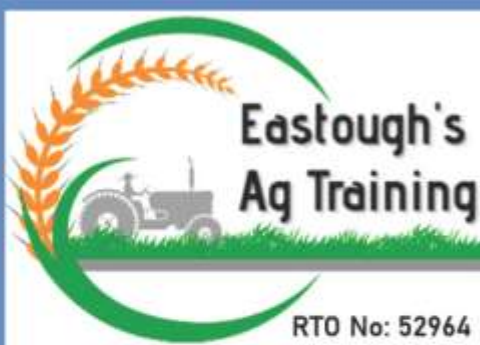
