What is the Staying in Place Program?

The Staying in Place Program is an innovative community approach that is making it possible for older people in rural and regional areas of Western Australia to stay living in their own home, in their own community.

It is a model that draws on 'locals supporting locals' through coordination from a local group and oversight of an approved aged care provider.

The Bruce Rock Community Resource Centre (BKCRC) has partnered with InCasa Country to bring this offering to seniors in Bruce Rock and the surrounding regions.

To enable the services required by older residents in our region, we are looking for people who have skills and experience in a variety of work, industries and interests.

Examples of services includes but is not limited to Personal Care, Transport Services, Domestic Assistance, Social Support, Meal Assistance, Nursing Services and Home Maintenance Services.

How it works

As an Independent Support Worker on Mable, you'll:

- Work as a sole trader, embracing the flexibility of being your own boss.
- Choose who you work with, when and the rates you charge.
- Make meaningful connections, allowing you to deliver the best support possible.
- Have insurance provided for including public liability, personal accident and professional indemnity.
- Gain access to free education with opportunities to participate in accredited training.
- Earn more per hour through the online platform, with Mable contractors recieving the agreed rate, less 10%.

What is nable?

Mable is an online platform that directly connects seniors with independent support workers.

It is the place where you find jobs posted, offer your services, create agreements with clients, submit timesheets and coordinates weekly payments.

More things to know

- You will need an **ABN** to sign up as a Mable worker. This is a simple online process through www.abr.gov.au
- Many different skills can be used through this program such as:
 - house cleaning
 - gardening
 - home maintenance
 - shopping assistance
 - meal preparation
 - social outings
 - transport to/from appointments

- 2. Head to www.mable.com.au to set up your online account. Please note you will need the following:
 - An ABN
 - Two personal or professional references
 - National Police Check (speak to BKCRC to get a free code)
 - Various forms of ID
- 3. Once your account is active, you will be able to access the jobs board, where you can select which jobs interest you.
- 4. You can then set your own rates, and available times.Payments are made weekly once you submit your timesheets online.
